## Connecting to the SPC-Members Wi-Fi network (Windows)

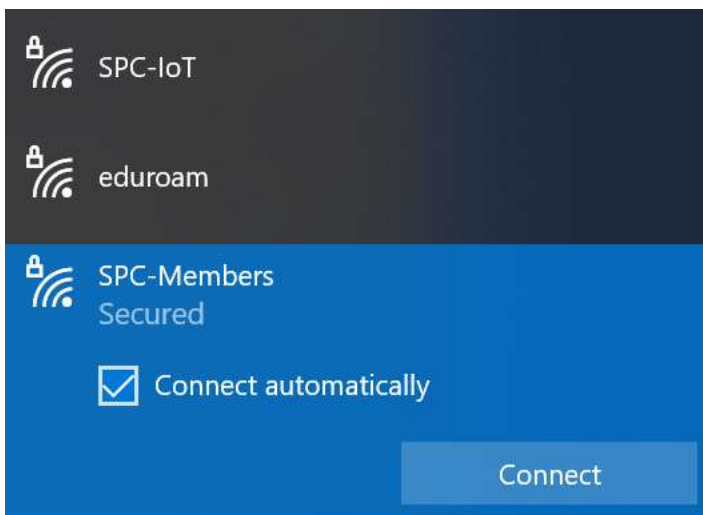
### Before you connect

You'll need to know your St. Peters *college account* username and password:

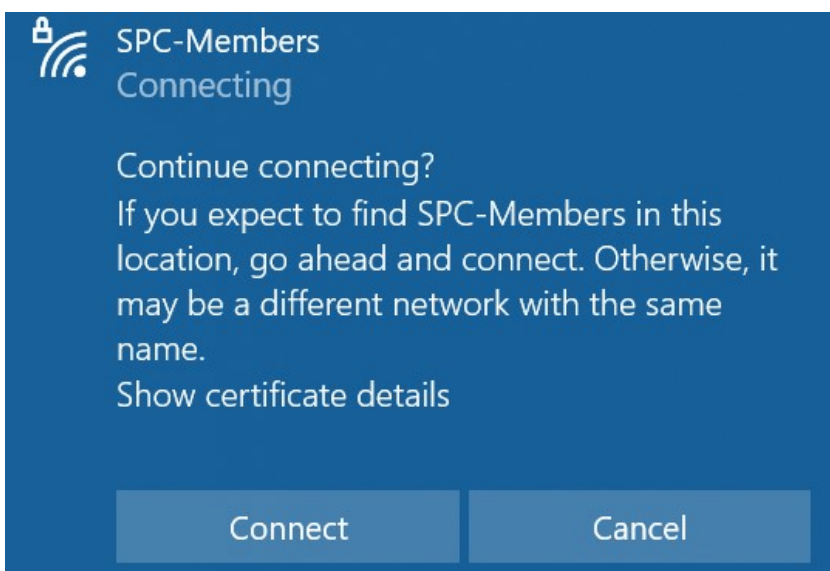
- Your username will be the first part of your Oxford Single Sign-On (for instance **spet1234**).
- If you don't know your college password it can be changed at this website:

### Find and join the network on your Windows device

Click 'Settings and select Wi-Fi' from the menu in the bottom right hand corner and click on the SPC-Members network:




Click connect.



Next, supply your username and password:


Username: spetxxxx – please replace with your SSO number
