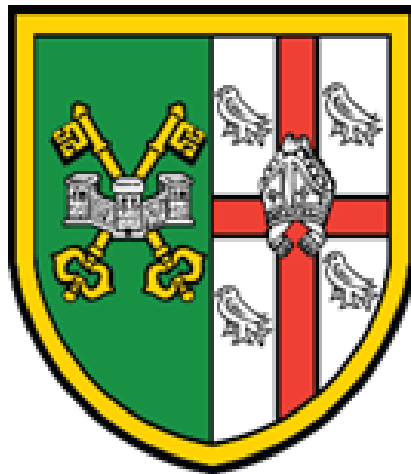

O how such eternal nourishment feeds the holy mind! O honey and sweet nectar! O blessed place! This delight, this peace, this goal draws us from here straight to Paradise. (*unattributed*)
