



HT21 – Covid-related rules

1. Maintain 2m social distancing with everyone who is not in your Household.
2. Follow the current UK Government guidance about whether/how you are allowed to meet up with others.
3. Wear a face covering in all indoor spaces (including corridors and stairwells) unless you are alone in a room, or you are only with members of your Household in your Household area. You may remove your face covering if eating or drinking.
4. Wipe down shared surfaces after you have used them (including bathrooms, kitchens, desks and chairs in the Library),
5. No visitors are allowed in College (including the annexes).
6. You should not permit people who are not members of your Household in your room or Household area. Do not enter any Household area other than your own.
7. If you have Covid-like symptoms:
 - a. Self-isolate immediately
 - b. Book a test via <https://www.ox.ac.uk/coronavirus/health/covid-testing>
 - c. Contact covid@spc.ox.ac.uk to alert the College to your situation
 - d. Follow all instructions you are given by the Testing Service and the College.
8. Read your SPC emails regularly (at least daily) and respond when requested.

We strongly recommend that you:

9. Hand-sanitise frequently.
